

Summer Employment Requirements

The following guidelines must be in place for Dry Gulch USA in order to properly meet State Labor Regulations:

| • 15 years of age or less: | Not Eligible |
| • 16 – 21 years of age: | Eligible, if currently enrolled in High School or Higher Education (see below for details) |
| • 22 years of age or older: | Not Eligible |

PLEASE NOTE:

- **Higher Education** is defined as any full-time or part-time Learning Center (i.e. college, vocational school, trade school, etc.)
- **Enrollment Verification:** Students must supply Dry Gulch USA with documentation of proof of enrollment in High School or Higher Education. High School students can bring a copy of their student I.D. and/or class schedule, and Higher Education enrollees must bring a proof of enrollment letter and/or class schedule supplied by the Educational Institution. (An acceptance letter does not qualify as a proper enrollment verification document.)
- **High School Graduates:** Students who have newly graduated High School must also show proof of enrollment in a Higher Education institution before qualifying for Dry Gulch USA summer employment.
- **If you are 15 years of age,** you are eligible to serve on select ministry teams on a volunteer basis.
